

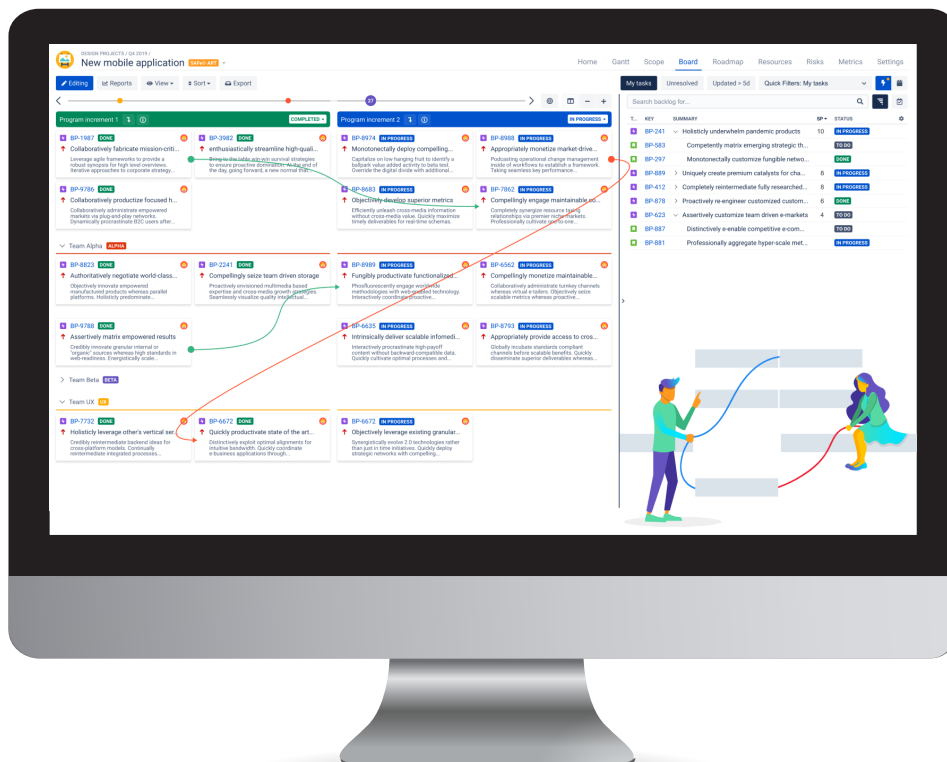
# HAVE YOU HEARD OF THE TOP FINDING BY PMI\*?
