LTC Vincent Boncich currently serves as the Chief of the Data Warfare Division (DWD), Technical Warfare Center for U.S. Army Cyber Command. He is the lead ORSA and principle lead for the ARCYBER Big Data Platform (BDP) Gabriel Nimbus (GN) to include platform enhancement and analytic development for Defensive Cyber Operations (DCO) and Network Operations (NetOps).



Before serving as the Chief of the DWD, LTC Boncich's assignment include TWI at Verizon Global Network Operations; Analyst at the Center for Army Analysis (CAA); Interagency Fellow at the U.S. Department of Labor; Project Manager at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineer, Norfolk District; Company Commander of Alpha Company, 1st Special Troops Battalion, 82nd Airborne Division; and other leadership and staff positions.

LTC Boncich earned a B.S. in Civil Engineering (2000) at Virginia Tech; a M.S. in Civil Engineering (2005) at the University of Missouri, Rolla; a M.S. in Industrial & Systems Engineering (2010) at Virginia Tech; and a M.S. in Operations Research (2016) at the Florida Institute of Technology.
